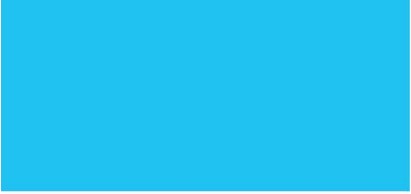

Early Literacy & Numeracy



By the end of Kindergarten I can:

- Write my name with a capital letter
- Identify both upper and lower case letters by name
- Identify sounds at the beginning, middle and end of spoken words
- Compose quantities within 10
- Represent a quantity in different ways
- Predict the next elements in a repeating pattern



Enhanced Supports



The classroom teacher is at the centre of your child's learning team and is supported by a school learning team. Based on classroom needs, each kindergarten program will also be supported by a multidisciplinary team that works with large and small groups in the classroom.

This team may consist of:

Education Assistants or Early Childhood Practitioners

Early Learning Strategists

Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs)

Psychologists

Occupational Therapists (OTs)

Physiotherapists (PTs)

School Family Liaison (SFL)

Getting Ready for Kindergarten



Build your child's independence by encouraging them to:



- dress themselves (zippers, buttons)
- use the bathroom and wash their hands on their own
- put away toys and help out in other small ways at home
- practice opening and closing snack containers and using a water bottle
- play games, take turns and compromise
- develop a consistent bedtime routine



Getting Ready for Kindergarten



Read to your child every day:

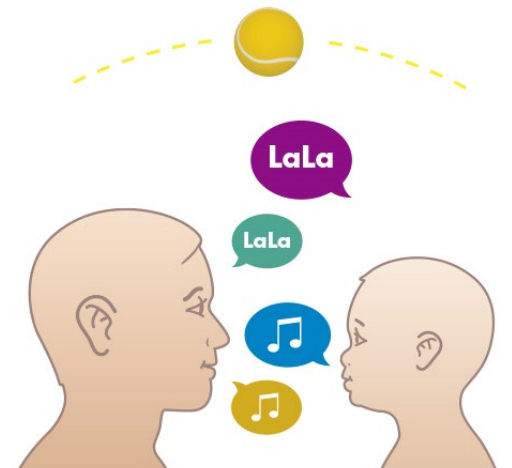
- read stories together in *your first language* to help your child develop vocabulary, listening and speaking skills
- enjoy reading different types of books: picture books, information books, nursery rhymes, poetry
- encourage your child to talk about the pictures and stories as you read together
- visit your community library (when possible)

Getting Ready for Kindergarten



Take time to talk with your child about everyday activities:

- share special activities together, such as walks to the park
- talk about what you are seeing and doing
- talk, read, sing and play in *your first language* every day
- praise children for their efforts and courage to overcome setbacks
- talk about how it is okay to make mistakes

Transportation | Bussing



- Register through MyCBE Account
- Deadline to be included in route planning for the fall is **Sunday, June 22, 2025.**
- There is no financial obligation for registration; families have until Sept. 30th to cancel without a fee
- Kindergarten transportation is one-way only, for arrival at school. You will need to arrange pick up at 10:50 (Mon-Thurs.) Students may ride both ways on Fridays.

If you have a **long document** tap the **camera** and then the **scan button** at the bottom of the app to translate the entire document.



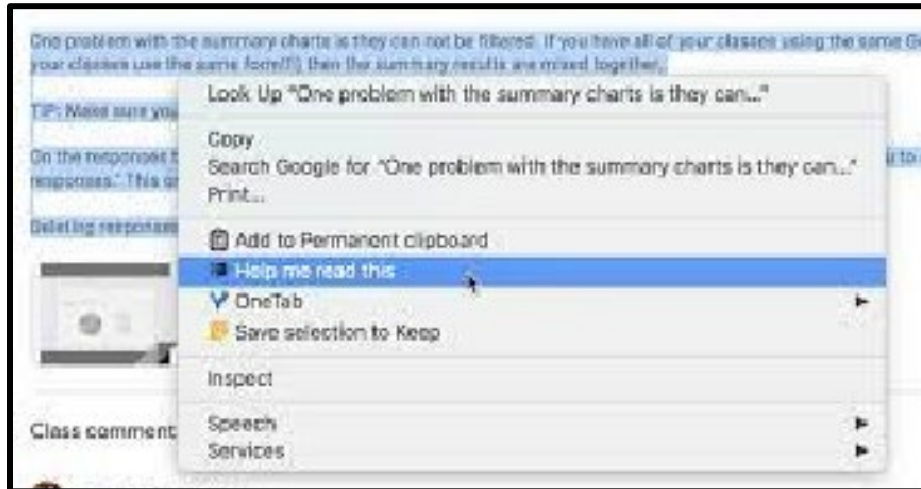
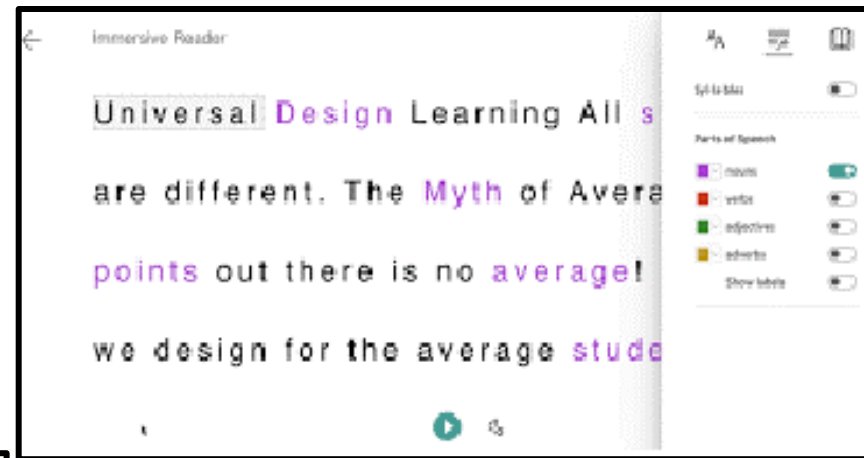
