Early Literacy & Numeracy













- •Write my name with a capital letter
- •Identify both upper and lower case letters by name
- •Identify sounds at the beginning, middle and end of spoken words
- •Compose quantities within 10
- Represent a quantity in different ways
- •Predict the next elements in a repeating pattern





Enhanced Supports









The classroom teacher is at the centre of your child's learning team and is supported by a school learning team. Based on classroom needs, each kindergarten program will also be supported by a multidisciplinary team that works with large and small groups in the classroom.

This team may consist of:

Education Assistants or Early Childhood Practitioners
Early Learning Strategists
Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs)
Psychologists
Occupational Therapists (OTs)
Physiotherapists (PTs)
School Family Liaison (SFL)

Getting Ready for Kindergarten











- dress themselves (zippers, buttons)
- use the bathroom and wash their hands on their own
- put away toys and help out in other small ways at home
- practice opening and closing snack containers and using a water bottle
- play games, take turns and compromise
- develop a consistent bedtime routine




Getting Ready for Kindergarten





Read to your child every day:







- •enjoy reading different types of books: picture books, information books, nursery rhymes, poetry
- •encourage your child to talk about the pictures and stories as you read together
- visit your community library (when possible)

Getting Ready for Kindergarten






Take time to talk with your child about everyday activities:



- share special activities together, such as walks to the park
- talk about what you are seeing and doing
- talk, read, sing and play in your first language every day
- praise children for their efforts and courage to overcome setbacks

School Hours:



Monday-Thursday 8:00 – 10:50 Alternating Fridays 8:00 – 12:00





- •Students are to meet the teacher at the Kindergarten (ramp) doors with their parent/caregiver
- •Students are picked up at the Kindergarten doors(ramp) by a **known** caregiver, documented in PowerSchool as an emergency contact
- •An adult caregiver must meet the bus, for students accessing this service











Transportation | Bussing









- Register through MyCBE Account
- Deadline to be included in route planning for the fall is <u>Sunday</u>, <u>June 22</u>, <u>2025</u>.
- There is no financial obligation for registration;
 families have until Sept. 30th to cancel without a fee
- Kindergarten transportation is <u>one-way only, for</u> arrival at school. You will need to arrange pick up at 10:50 (Mon-Thurs.) Students may ride both ways on Fridays.

- Safe for physical education




















Backpack

- School work




Snack










If you have a **long document tap the camera** and then the scan button at the bottom of the app to translate the entire document.










Immersive Reader








